Judge Rivera is serving her fourth term as Judge of the 168th Judicial District Court. She previously served as an Associate Family Law Judge, Criminal Law Magistrate and Assistant District Attorney. She is the former Local Administrative Judge for the El Paso County Council of Judges.

Under the direction of Judge Rivera the El Paso Commission for Women sponsored a conference that brought the issue of domestic violence to the fore front. Resulting in great changes in the way courts, prosecutors and law enforcement dealt with domestic violence cases in El Paso.

She is a frequent speaker at continuing legal education seminars sponsored by the State Bar, has served as Chair of the Litigation Section of the State Bar of Texas. Furthermore, served as Chair of the Women & The Law Section of the State Bar of Texas.

She has been honored for her numerous contributions to our communities including the Lenore Walker Award for her work in connection with domestic violence (1993) and was presented the Texas Bar Foundation Sam Pessara Outstanding Jurist Award for the State of Texas (2001), presented with a community service award by the Black El Paso Democrats (1993). Inducted into the El Paso County Democratic Hall of Fame by Congressmen Silvestre Reves.
